Children's Programs

Children & Worship — following the Time with Young Disciples during worship, children ages 4 years to 5th grade are invited to follow Marina Greiner and an adult helper upstairs to the Upper Room above the Narthex. Children will engage in a simplified and age-appropriate order of worship that includes liturgical greetings, songs of praise, and a sensorimotor style of storytelling that follows the Bible passages of the church year calendar.
